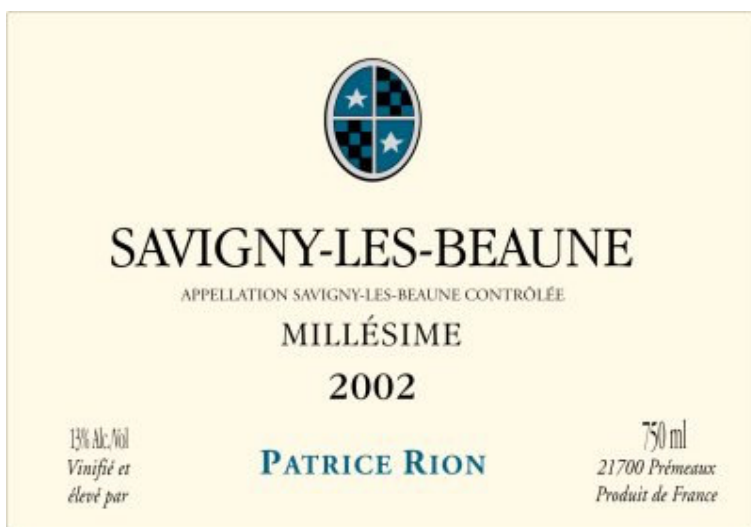

Red Savigny-les Beaune wines show a medium-intense color, with an elegant, powerful nose marked by black and redcurrant and raspberry aromas. With age the nose evolves into strawberries and forest scents. Supple, with discreet tannins and medium acidity, the wine has a light and delicate structure which gives it a more feminine nature. The 1er Crus have more character and power, and require medium cellaring.

- Grape Variety :** Pinot noir  
**Alcoholic content :** 13°  
**Cases produced :** 450  
**Soil :** Argileous limestone  
**Aging :** Oak barrels, 30% new  
**Vineyard Location :** Several different vineyards around Savigny-les-Beaune

**Characteristics :** The only Cote de Beaune wine in our range. Very pleasant and easy to drink while young. More floral and supple than wines from the Côte de Nuits.
- Storage and aging :** Keep cool (around 12C) in a dark place with constant temperatures. Store the bottles on their sides, and serve around 17C. Best between 4-7 years old.
- To drink with :** Grilled meat.
