

Smoky oak lends an immediate appeal, then the black cherry, plum and mineral flavors show their colors. There's an impression of sweet fruit overall, yet this is also ripe and firm. Chewy tannins on the finish require cellaring.



Endowed with oak, this evokes sweet spice, along with plum and blackberry flavors. A bit flashy, with good concentration and a tannic finish.

Quite oaky, sporting vanilla and spice aromas and flavors, but there are also apple, toasted hazelnut and citrus notes. Dense, with a firm structure and a long finish. Best from 2008 through 2016.
